Partnership in Missions

Pioneers:

In 2025, Zach has continued to have the privilege to serve Pioneers by leading Venture, their mid-term overseas missions' program. Zach and his team are currently coaching 91 missionary candidates as they seek to serve the Lord by taking the Good News of Jesus to the Unreached peoples of the world.

Venture currently has 14 people serving with long term Pioneers church planting teams in Japan, Kyrgyzstan, India, Thailand, Japan, Tunisia, Kosovo, UAE, Sri Lanka, and Chad.

Finally, just this week Pioneers is embarking on a new Vision that its international leadership received from God in 2024. The vision is to see 250 new Unreached People Groups impacted through their witness to Jesus in the next 10 years. There are still roughly 4500 UPGS in the world today and God has impressed it upon the hearts of Pioneers leadership for a doubling of His portion to us. Since Pioneers began in 1978, God has worked through their missionaries to engage over 250 ethnic groups where disciples have been made, and churches have been planted! Now, God is calling them into greater things by stepping out in faith, surrendering their will, and relying on Him to proclaim His name among the nations.

Please join them in praying that God would strengthen their existing workers, and raise up thousands of new workers to take the Gospel to these 250 people groups that have little to no access to the Gospel.
